General Terms and Conditions for Tenders

1. Interested bidders can purchase the tender documents online from website.eproc.punjab.gov.in.
2. Earnest money shall be paid in online mode only.
3. Processing fee will only be accepted through Net Banking (Direct Debit) and IPG (Credit/Debit card).
4. All the payments (EMD & Tender form cost) and related document will be accepted online only.
5. Bidders/Contractors/tenderers can access tender documents on the website mentioned above, fill them and submit the complete tender document into electronically on the website. Bidders/Contractors shall attach scanned copies of all the documents, i.e. Earnest Money, Processing Fee, Tender cost fee and certificates/documents as required in terms and conditions.
6. Corrigendum/Addendum/Corrections, if any will be posted on the website only.
7. NIT and Terms and conditions have been/uploaded on website (eproc.punjab.gov.in.), agencies should note that online tenders should only be submitted at the aforesaid website eproc.punjab.gov.in as per the details/instructions uploaded therein.
8. NIT, Terms and conditions can be seen in the office of Municipal Corporation on any working day.
9. All legal proceedings in connection with the contract shall be subject to the territorial jurisdiction of the civil courts at Bathinda only.
10. For any other query bidders can contact the undersigned office on any working day.
11. Agency should compulsory upload the scanned copy of document such as PAN No., GST No., EPF No., ESIC No., Self Declaration that the contractor /L&C Societies / Firms has not been blacklisted till the publication of tender notice, Identity proof, Capacity Certificate, Should be submitted in Technical Bid. In case of absence of any of the above document, the bidder shall not be eligibility to participate. If the Contractor/L&C Society/Firms does not have EPF No. and ESIC No. then the agency has to submit these documents before the allotment of work, within 7 days of opening the technical bid. If these documents are not submitted by Contractor/L&C Society/Firms then their earnest money will be forfeited.

12. The L&C Co-Operative Societies shall submit its capacity certificate from the concerned authority of Co-Operative department along with tender.
13. Electronic tenders shall be opened in the office of the Corporation Engineer in the presence of Contractors or their authorized representatives (if they wish) on the date and time prescribed in the tender notice.
14. If tender date happens to be a holiday, the technical and financial bid will be opened on the next working day. Regarding this, no separate publication in Newspaper/website will be given.
15. The rates shall be quoted by the agency on commission basis for the collection of garbage charges. Rates quoted by the contractor inclusive all types of taxes, octroi, royalty and levies etc.
16. Tax and other levies will be deducted from the contractor's bill as per rules.
17. DNIT and MW-4 shall be the part of the agreement.
18. Any or all tenders can be rejected by the competent Authority without assigning any reason.
19. Conditional tenders shall not be accepted.
20. The unbalanced tenders shall be rejected.
