- 2. Earnest money shall be paid in online mode only.
- Processing fee will only be accepted through Net Banking (Direct Debit) and IPG (Credit/Debit card).
- 4. All the payments (EMD & Tender form cost) and related document will be accepted online only.
- 5. Bidders/Contractors/tenderers can access tender documents on the website mentioned above, fill them and submit the complete tender document into electronically on the website. Bidders/Contractors shall attach scanned copies of all the documents, i.e., Earnest Money, Processing Fee, Tender cost fee and certificates/documents as required in terms and conditions.

- 13. The L&C Co-Operative Societies shall submit its capacity certificate from the concerned authority of Co-Operative department along with tender.
- 14. The Contractor/Firms/ L&C Co-Operative Society must have got EPF code no. and ESIC prior to opening of tenders (As applicable).
- 15. The L&C Co-Operative Societies will have to submit a financial capacity certificate issued by Registrar, Co-Operative Societies. They will have to submit detail of their ongoing works in all departments. Works more than their financial capacity will not be allotted as directed by Director Local Govt. Punjab vide his letter No. 2123-24 dated 19.1.2021.

16. Bid Capacity:

The bid capacity of the prospective bidders will be calculated as under:

Assessed Available Bid Capacity = (A* N* 2 - B)

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A = Maximum value of Civil Engineering works executed in any one year (year means financial year) during the last five years (updated to the price level of the financial year in which bids are received at a rate per year as indicated in the BDS) taking into account the completed as well as works in progress.

N = Number of years prescribed for completion of the Project/Works for which these bids are being invited. (e.g. 7 months = 7/12 year)

B = Value (updated to the price level of the year indicated in B D S) of existing commitments (only allotted works) on the last date of submission of bids as per bidding document and on-going works to be completed during the period of completion of the Project/Works for which these bids are being invited.

Note: The statement showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be attached along with certificates duly signed by the Engineer-in Charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent. The contractor/Society also have to submit self-attested undertaking that the Society/Contractor is eligible to take part in the tender and has available bid capacity on the basis of above formula.

Other Terms and Conditions for Tender Item No. 1

- 1. Rates quoted by the contractor should include all types of taxes and levies etc.
- 2. The man power shall be deputed throughout the period on as and when required by the department basis
- 3. This rate will be same for all categories.
- 4. The agency shall be bound to obey all labour laws and shall fulfill all the responsibilities of Municipal Corporation, Bathinda as principal employer like EPF, ESI labour cess, Insurance, Medical, Service Tax etc. and other labour welfare laws applicable.
- 5. The various categories of man power are as below (or categories as per Government Gazette/Notification: -



- 1. Skilled (i.e. Supervisor, Driver, Electrician, Mason, Fitter, Clerk, Munshi etc.)

- The contractor should submit EPF, ESI and Service Tax, Challan Copy along with bill.
- The rate shall be quoted on percentage chargeable over prevailing DC rates. The lowest bidder on such quoted chargeable percentage above DC rate shall be declared L1.
- If DC rate of any categories is revised or any statutory liability like EPF, ESI, Service Tax etc. are revised during tender period; the agency shall be paid accordingly.
- Criminal proceeding shall be initiated if agency fails in meeting any of the statutory liabilities like deposit of EPF, ESI, Service Tax, GST, Insurance, Medical etc. in appropriate account.
